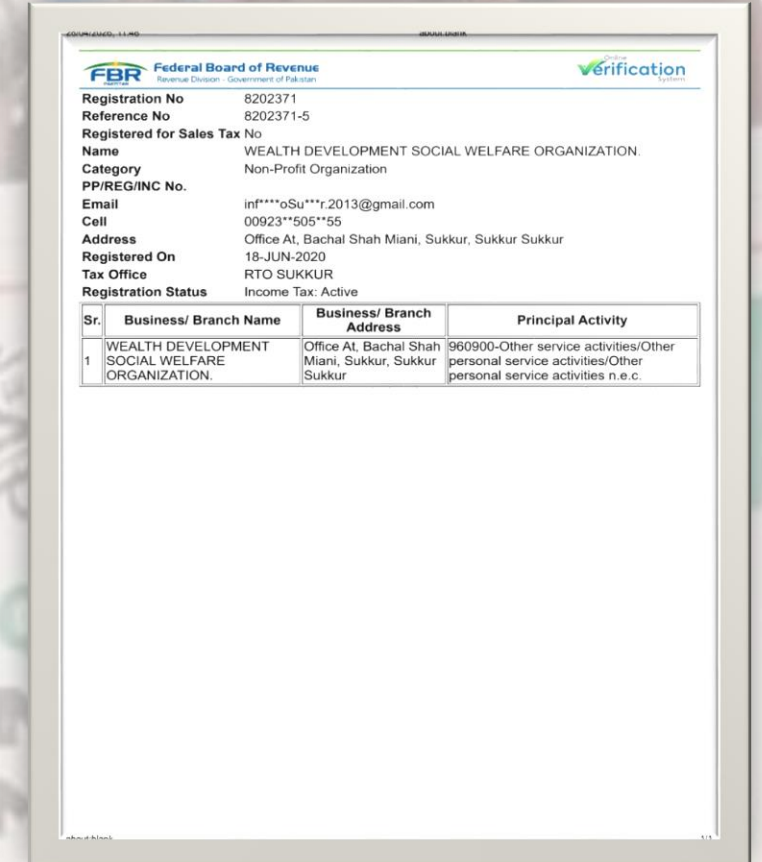

# About Us

- ✓ Wealth Development Social Welfare Organization (WDSWO) is a registered non-profit, non-governmental organization established on 30th September 2013, with its headquarters in Sukkur, Sindh, Pakistan.
- ✓ WDSWO is registered under the Voluntary Social Welfare Agencies (Registration and Control) Ordinance 1961 (Registration No. DO/SW/SUK/V.A 169), the Sindh Charities Registration and Regulation Commission, and the Federal Board of Revenue — making it a fully compliant, transparent, and accountable organization.
- ✓ Since its founding, WDSWO has grown from a grassroots community initiative into a credible humanitarian and development organization delivering impactful interventions across Upper Sindh. Over more than a decade of service, WDSWO has responded to chronic development gaps and acute emergencies — including the catastrophic floods of 2022 — reaching over one million beneficiaries across five districts.
- ✓ Guided by the values of accountability, transparency, integrity, honesty, and teamwork, WDSWO works in close collaboration with local communities, government departments, and development partners to ensure that the most vulnerable — including women, children, persons with disabilities, and flood-affected families — are reached with dignity and care.

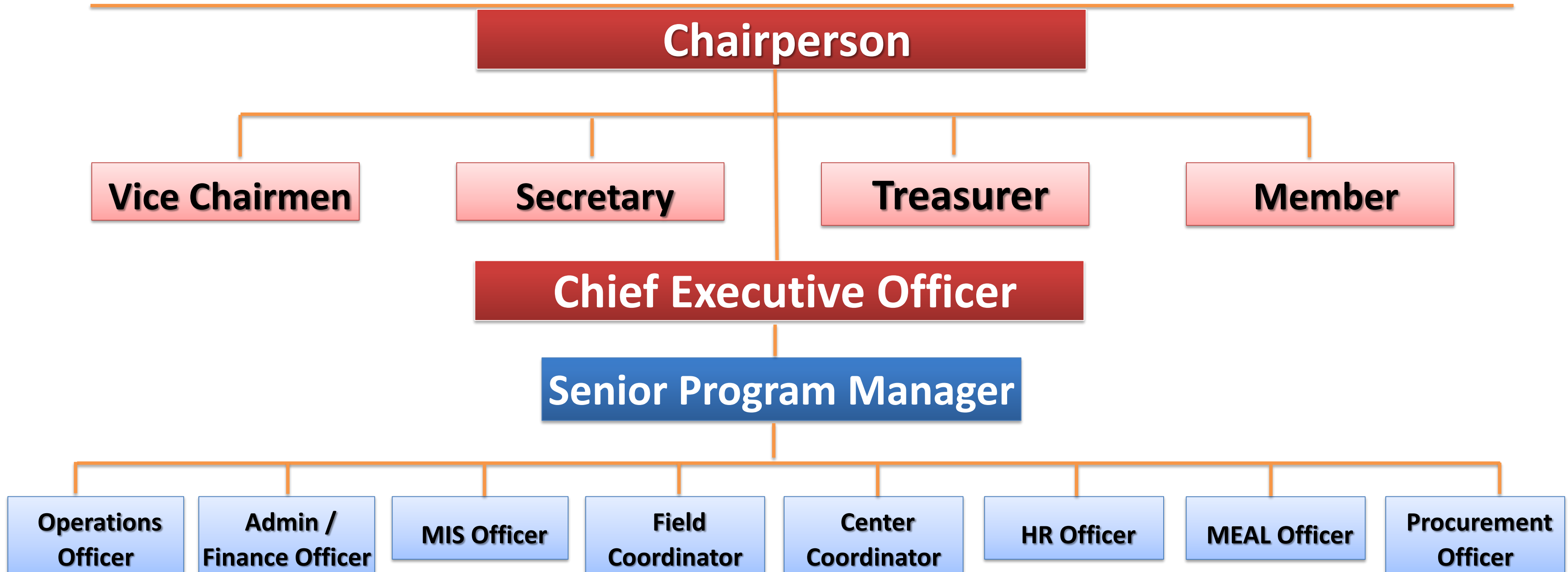

# Health & Medical Services

- Access to basic healthcare remains a distant reality for millions living in rural Sindh. Since its inception, WDSWO has been working alongside communities and government health departments to bridge this gap — improving physical infrastructure, strengthening service delivery, and bringing free medical care directly to underserved populations.
- Through mobile medical camps, general OPD services, and specialist eye camps, WDSWO has served thousands of patients who would otherwise have no access to healthcare. During the 2022 floods, WDSWO scaled up its health response significantly, operating emergency medical camps and facilitating eye surgeries for flood-affected victims.

# Safe Drinking Water & Wash Facilities

- Safe drinking water is a fundamental human right — yet in the rural communities where WDSWO works, an estimated 70% of the population lacks access to clean water. Underground water sources, while widely used, often carry harmful contaminants that cause serious illnesses including diarrhea, skin disease, and waterborne infections.
- WDSWO's Water & WASH Programmed addresses this critical gap through the installation of hand pumps, solar motor pumps, community water tanks, and solar water filtration systems. By combining infrastructure with community awareness on safe water practices, WDSWO is helping families protect their health and well-being for the long term.

# Dowry & Marriage Support Programme

- In many rural communities across Pakistan, the cultural expectation of providing a dowry at marriage places an enormous financial burden on impoverished families — often leaving young women unable to marry for years due to their family's inability to meet these costs.
- WDSWO's Dowry & Marriage Support Programme directly addresses this barrier to dignity. By providing carefully curated dowry packages to deserving families, WDSWO ensures that young women can begin their married lives with respect and without placing their families in financial hardship.
- Packages include essential household items such as gold sets, wooden beds, dinner sets, bridal clothing, and other domestic necessities — selected with care and sensitivity to community needs.

# Disability Inclusion & Support Programme

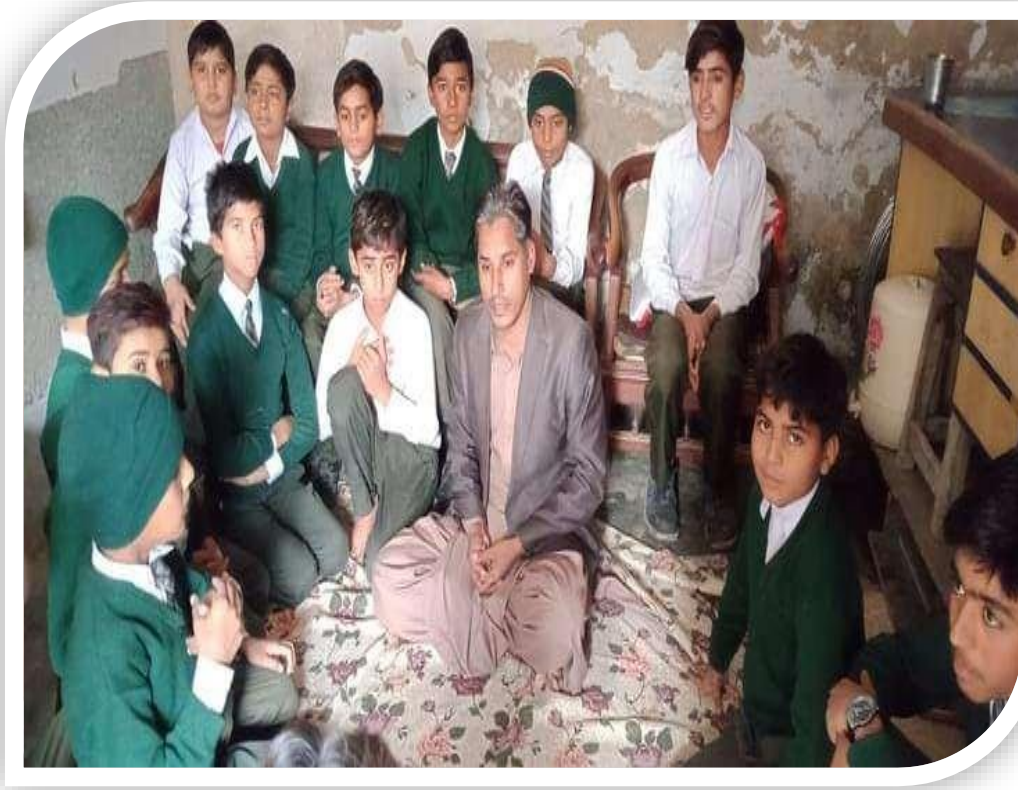
- Persons with disabilities (PWDs) in Pakistan face compounding disadvantages — limited mobility, social exclusion, and lack of access to assistive devices leave many unable to participate fully in daily life. WDSWO is committed to breaking down these barriers and championing the rights, dignity, and independence of every individual.
- Through its Disability Inclusion Programme, WDSWO distributes mobility aids and assistive devices to persons with disabilities across its target districts — enabling them to move freely, engage with their communities, and pursue a more independent life.

# Education & Literacy Programme

- Education is the foundation of every thriving society — yet for millions of children in rural Sindh, quality education remains inaccessible due to poverty, inadequate infrastructure, and lack of basic learning materials.
- WDSWO's Education Programme works to remove these barriers through targeted support to underprivileged students and schools. From distributing uniforms, shoes, and stationery to organizing awareness sessions and educational competitions, WDSWO is helping to create an environment where every child can learn with confidence and dignity.

- By coordinating the collection and distribution of Qurbani meat to deserving households, WDSWO enables less fortunate families to celebrate with dignity alongside their communities. This programme reflects WDSWO's broader commitment to social inclusion, compassion, and the values of Islamic charity.

- The holy month of Ramadan is a time of reflection, prayer, and communal solidarity. WDSWO's Ramadan Iftar and Food Dastarkhwan Programme ensures that no one in our communities breaks their fast alone or hungry — regardless of their economic circumstances.
- By organizing daily iftar gatherings and food distribution events throughout Ramadan, WDSWO brings people together around a shared table, fostering a deep sense of belonging, compassion, and mutual support. These events serve not only as a source of nourishment but as a powerful symbol of unity and care within the community.



# Emergency & Disaster Response Programme

- When disaster strikes, speed and coordination can mean the difference between survival and devastation. WDSWO's Emergency Response Programme is built on the principles of rapid mobilization, community-centred action, and comprehensive relief — ensuring that affected populations receive timely, dignified assistance when they need it most.
- Working in close coordination with local authorities, community leaders, and development partners, WDSWO deploys trained volunteers and resources to affected areas within hours of an emergency. From food and ration distribution to medical camps, water pumping services, and shelter support, WDSWO's emergency interventions are designed to address the full spectrum of immediate needs.



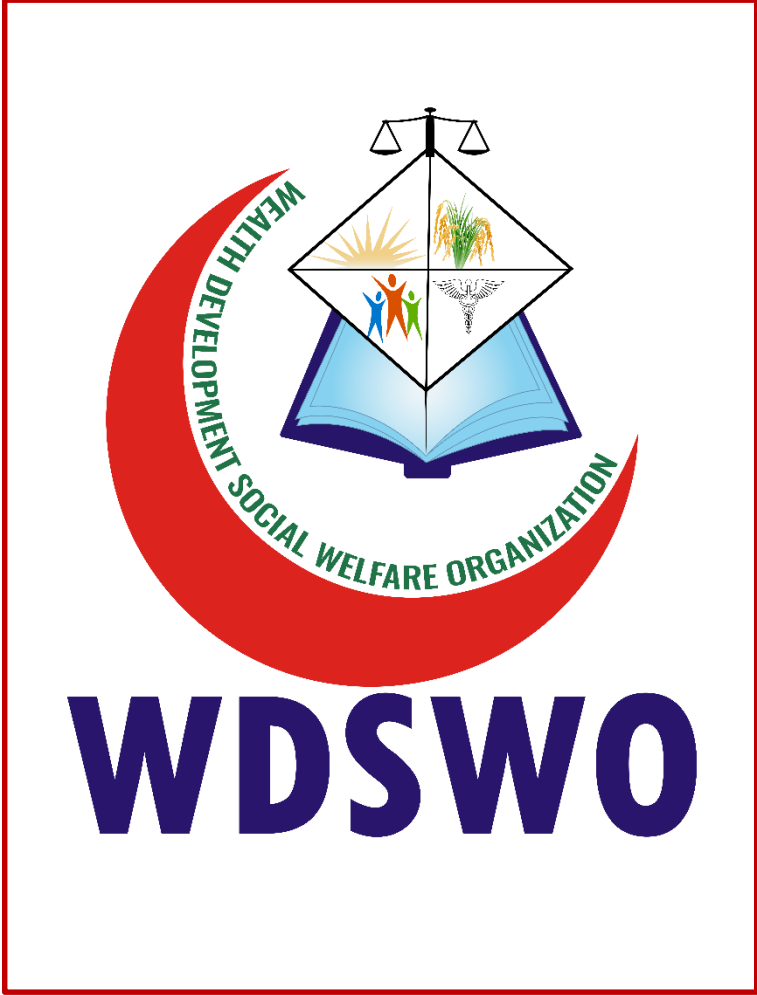
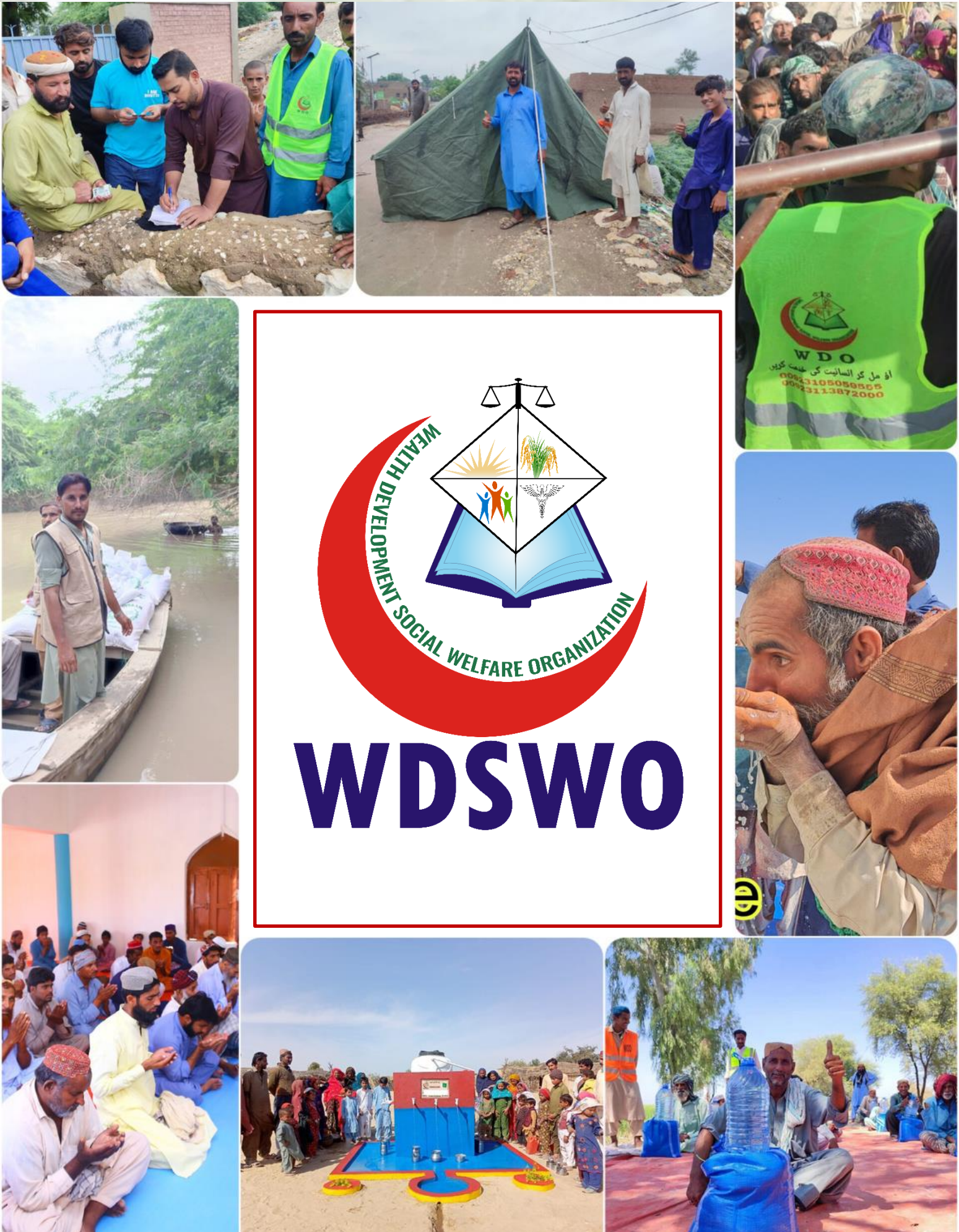

# WDSWO Flood Emergency Response - 2022

- *WDSWO's largest-ever emergency operation — mobilizing volunteers, resources, and partnerships across Upper Sindh in response to Pakistan's most devastating floods in decades.*
- ✓ **Emergency Water Pumping Services — District Sukkur** (04 pumps operating 24 hours)
- ✓ **Non-Food Item Distribution — District Sukkur** (1,000+ tarpaulins, shoppers & mosquito nets)
- ✓ **Winterization Response — District Sukkur** (1,500+ winter blankets distributed in coordination with Deputy Commissioner Sukkur)
- ✓ **Shelter & Medical Evacuation Support** (300+ tents distributed | Free ambulance services for flood victims)
- ✓ **Free Eye Camp for Flood Victims** (310+ OPD | 200+ eyeglasses | 18 eye surgeries)
- ✓ **Emergency Food Ration Distribution** (1,500 ration bags distributed to flood-affected families)
- ✓ **Daily Hot Meal Distribution** (Lunch & dinner served daily to displaced flood victims)
- ✓ **Clean Water Infrastructure — Flood Response** (120 clean water projects including solar filter tanks, community tanks, hand pumps & wazu khanas)
- ✓ **Emergency Medical Camps** (04 mega free medical camps providing first aid & medicines to flood victims)

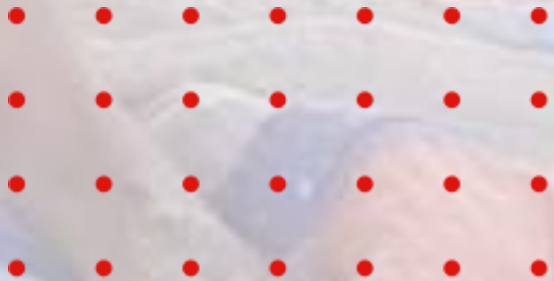
